




About 70% of the land rights in the world are not documented



Participative methods got a lot of local support from the village


Surveyors in Kenya recognise their changing role in land registration. Government in Kenya is accepting new FFP methods as tested

Important stakeholders were convinced to start using the FFP approach


There are many possibilities, for instance to carry out a pilot, language will be less of a problem since some Spanish or English can be used.



According to the meeting UN-GGIM can further organise the demand in LA. Besides, new countries have been familiarised with FFP


That FFP is used as a term, instead of an approach. We have to prevent it becomes a trend. It has to be a call to action
